

How to Drop the Lowest Grade

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Dropping the Lowest Grades in Sakai Gradebook:

In Sakai Gradebook you may set it up so that it drops the lowest grade (or multiple grades) in any grading category. To do so, follow these steps:

1. Navigate to the course Gradebook and click the top tab labeled, "Settings".

2. Select the section labeled, "Categories and Weighting".



3. Check off the box labeled "Drop lowest".
